Pick-up time can be challenging. I understand this. At the moment, we have started the process to address local council around the issues. In the meantime, please make sure you follow our simple little rules.

- ◆ Move right up in the Kiss and Drop Zone. Move forward when there is an opportunity to do so.
- ◆ If you don't fit, please go down to the bottom car park.
- ◆ Parents are NOT to get out of the car whilst in the Kiss and Drop Zone.
- ◆ If you need to get out of the car, please go down to the bottom car park.

We have had a few incidents take place over the last week. These rules are here to ensure the **Kiss and Drop Zone** is safe to use for parents and students. Please follow them. If you or your child cannot perform the above expectations, then it's best to drive down to the bottom car park. I'll be out there over the next fortnight to ensure these rules are followed. Don't hold any harsh feelings if I come over for a chat about the above. Remember, parents are to stay in the car!

A reminder to families that we are running a **Bunnings Sausage Sizzle this Sunday!** Pop in and grab yourself a sausage or two to support our school.

Our School Concert is approaching. Tickets will be on sale early next week with a message to notify parents via compass. We will be travelling to the venue via bus for a rehearsal the day of the concert. Students will depart school at 9am and return at 3pm. The cost for bussing students to and from the venue for the rehearsal is \$10. Payment needs to be made via compass.

The Great Doreen Bike Ride is on tomorrow.
Find some details below around the event.

- Students need to arrive between 8:00am-8:45am at the Diamond Creek Netball Courts!
- Students and Bikes are to be picked up from the Diamond Creek Netball Courts at 3:00pm.
- Students need to be in full school uniform for the ride.
- Students need to bring their bike and helmet! Don't forget these!
- All students need to bring a **practical** backpack. Inside this your child will need their snack, lunch and a drink bottle filled with water. Keep this backpack as light as possible (no satchels or bumbags). No other items are needed!
- When you arrive, find your designated class area.
- There will be a volunteer meeting at 8:55am. Once we've finished the meeting, we will set off on the ride.

What to do tonight for the GDBR.

- Check your child's tyre pressure. If it's low, pump it up.
- Ensure the brakes on your child's bike are working as needed and are not getting caught on the tyre.
- Check the brake cables (at times, these twist and shorten, thus not allowing the child to turn left or right).
- Adjust your child's helmet to the right size.
- Put your child's helmet and bike in the car.

What to do tomorrow morning.

- Ensure your child has a healthy breakfast.
- Ensure your child is in full school uniform and sunscreen has been applied.
- Make sure your child has a small backpack with a snack, lunch and drink bottle inside.
- Make sure your child's helmet and bike are in the car!

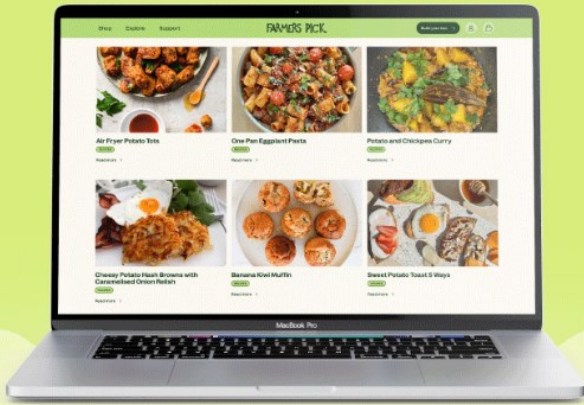
