On the topic of fundraising, School Council have created an account with "Farmers Pick". Farmers Pick is an organisation that allows you to get imperfect fruit and veg for anywhere between 28% to 41% percent cheaper than your major supermarket chains. For every order that is completed (weekly or fortnightly) the school will receive a \$5 donation per box. If we have 10 families sign up, we will receive \$50 a week through a passive fundraiser as such. The only catch, your fruit and veg box won't be delivered to your home, it will get delivered to the school and you'll have to pick it up from here. Families can now order their fruit and vegetable box through Farmers Pick! (see attachment) To do so, head over to the Farmers Pick website (or click on attachment), create yourself an account and when placing your order, select Doreen Primary School as your designated school via the "Join the Feed our School Program". Ensure your order is placed for delivery for the 1st week back of Term 3.


