


From Dave

A reminder to parents that if you're enrolling your child into Doreen PS for 2025 under the sibling claim, can you please return your enrolment form as soon as possible. Our list of enrolments for 2025 is quite long and I'd be disappointed if we had families in our community that left it until the last minute.

The staggered car park is going to continue for the rest of this term. Our building works are running on track, which means the kiss and drop zone should be back for the start of Term 3. Again, for those families that struggle and cannot make the 3:20pm pick up, let me know and we can arrange to move you to 3:30pm. Our survey that went out at the beginning of the week had some resounding responses.

- * **86.3**% of our families find the staggered system positive and easier for their family.
- 5% of our families find it less positive and harder.
- 8.8% of our families haven't noticed a difference (some of these parents are our later pickups and arrive around 3:40pm).

With these responses - the current 3:20/3:30pm pick up system will continue until the end of term. I thank you all for your responses.
